This is a unique opportunity to lead the management and development of country responsible investment networks worldwide as a member of a dynamic and expanding team at the UN-backed Principles for Responsible Investment. PRI has more than 900 signatories around the world, representing over \$30 trillion in assets under management. PRI's mission is to support these institutions in their efforts to embed environmental, social and governance factors in their operations. PRI currently has staff on the ground in Brazil, South Africa, South Korea, Germany and Japan. Recruitment is under way for positions in the US and Australia. This position will manage this team and lead the further development of the Networks Team.

This post reports to the Director of Strategic Development.

Specific tasks include:

- Leading a team of five country-based staff (soon to increase to seven) – including objective setting and performance management, skills development and coaching
- Lead relationships with PRI signatories in Europe
- Ensuring the delivery to PRI signatories of support materials and programs developed at the global level – working closely with the Implementation Support, Clearinghouse, Academic Network and Public Policy teams
- Capturing country-level PRI implementation experience and disseminating it across the global PRI signatory base
- Representing PRI at conferences and other events

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- Deliver support to signatories on the PRI Reporting and Assessment process
 - Contributing to PRI signatory recruitment, working closely with the Global Recruitment Manager
 - Contribute actively to the overall development of PRI as a member of the Management Team

Requirements and likely experience:

- 5-10 years' management experience, including managing remote teams
- Good knowledge of responsible investment and sustainability issues
- Strong experience of organizing and running workshops and similar events
- Strong team player and networker
